

GS Data Tool Registration Form

Note: You *do not* need to complete this form if someone from your organization has already done so. Please communicate with your project team to confirm whether or not this process has been completed.

To receive credentials for EPA's GS Data Tool, fill in the requested information below and email the form to GSDataTool@epa.gov. Following the receipt of account credentials, you will be able to log in to the GS Data Tool at <https://epa.VELO.pnnl.gov/share/page/operators>.

Credentials are assigned on a *per-project basis* regardless of the number of Class VI wells that will be used for injection at the proposed project. Because only one set of credentials will be issued to an organization for a particular project, it is the owner or operator's responsibility to make sure that only authorized individual(s) or their designee(s) have access to the username and password.
